

CHILDCARE AT AIDS 2006

Limited space is available for the daily care of children of delegates at AIDS 2006. Here are some facts about the childcare services that can help you decide if you would like to register your child(ren) for childcare.

Registration: Children must be pre-registered for childcare. Childcare is also only available to children of registered delegates. The delegate's registration number is needed before childcare registration can be initiated.

Ages: Childcare is offered for children between the ages of 18 months and 12 years.

Days and times: childcare is available Monday 14 August to Friday 18 August during the day (approximately 8.30am to 5.30pm – times vary according to the facility being used – see below).

Cost: daycare is provided free of charge to delegates.

Consent and medical forms: a number of forms need to be completed in order to process the childcare registration (health forms, consent forms etc). A package of forms will be sent to each delegate who registers a child(ren).

Facilities:

1. [Daycare Connection at Simcoe Place](http://www.daycareconnection.ca): for children aged 18 months to 6 years. This is a well-respected childcare facility located directly opposite the Conference venue (Metro Toronto Convention Centre). Early Childhood Education staff offer stimulating programmes in the Montessori system. Times for drop-off and pick-up are: 7am and 6pm. Meals and snacks are included. 2. [The 519 Summer Day Camp](http://www.the519.org): for children aged 6 to 12 years. The 519 Church Street Community Centre is located in Downtown Toronto, 5 short subway stops from the Conference venue. Day Camp staff are usually summer students who arrange fun and stimulating programmes and outings for the children. Times for drop-off and pick-up are: 8.30am and 5.30pm. Snacks are included but children need to bring their own lunch. More information can be found at www.the519.org
